ENTRY REGULATIONS

Saturday 26th September 2020 SACU Permit No. 20038

THE TRIAL

A National Restricted Trial open to holders of 2020 Licences issued by the SACU or ACU or a Federation whose country is a member of the European Community. Holders of Licences issued by Federations other than the SACU or ACU must have written starting permission from their FMN, personal accident insurance and valid repatriation insurance. These must be produced upon arrival at the venue. The KDMCC will NOT be held responsible for repatriation of any Competitor. One Event Licences are not available for this event.

The format for this trial will be **one route over two laps**.

Entry will be limited to **approx. 150** riders.

VENUE

Registration and Start will be at the car park of Glencoe Mountain Resort, Glencoe.

START TIME:

Saturday 9.30 am (In-vehicle registration observing all social distancing protocols will begin at 8.00 am)
all riders MUST inform the Clerk of the Course or other club officials when they leave the venue)

COURSE

All on private ground
2 laps, 20 sections per lap, approx 12 miles per lap – 5 ½ hours permitted to complete the course

AWARDS

Due to Covid-19 restrictions scores will not be completed on the day so no announcement of winners will be made on the day. Results will be published on the KDMCC website on Thursday 1st of October.

SUPPLEMENTARY REGULATIONS

PLEASE ENSURE YOU READ AND AGREE TO ALL SUPPLEMENTARY REGULATIONS

1. Method of deciding ties will be in accordance with TSR 25.
2. Marking will be in accordance with TSR 22 - Non stop.
3. All sections must be ridden in number order on all laps.
4. Rider Numbers will be allocated by the Club Committee, taking into account as far as is possible any preferences for riding companions expressed at the time of application.
5. Riders will set off in 5 per minute intervals in groups of four, in numerical order.
6. Riders MUST keep to the flagged route. Any rider caught breaking this rule, will be excluded immediately.
7. Sections will be closed by the back marker. **The time limit will be 5 ½ hours.** There will be a 1 point-per-minute penalty for riders taking longer than 5 ½ hours.
8. Registration Card / Competition Licence / Repatriation Insurance MUST be shown upon arrival.
9. Closing date for entries is 23rd August 2020. (no late entries).
10. All entry fees (£25) are NON REFUNDABLE unless cancelled due to Covid-19 restrictions.
11. Helmet or Body Cameras are NOT ALLOWED (cf: SACU Bulletin February 2016). Cameras attached to the machine are permitted, subject to permission from the Clerk of the Course.
12. I confirm that I am not currently suspended from ACU/SACU permitted competition or on the ACU/SACU Stop List as a result of incurring a concussion injury. I shall notify the Club should I incur such a suspension or concussion injury between now and this event.
13. All bikes must be as per factory: NO DISC BRAKES: tubeless tyres are allowed.
14. Please check for any FINAL INSTRUCTIONS on the day.
15. Please do not leave any litter.
16. No Bikes are allowed to follow the trial. This will jeopardize any future use of the ground and is a strict instruction from the Landowners, on whom we depend. Please adhere to this, to ensure our future use of the ground.
17. Any rider found practising on any part of the course which lies on private ground will be disqualified.
18. **All riders will be met in their vehicles by a Club Official upon arrival at the Glencoe Mountain Resort Car Park on Saturday morning and MUST declare their departure from the site when they complete the course OR RETIRE EARLY. This is to ensure accurate scoring and safe closure of the course.**
19. A lunch voucher is included in the cost of entry – these will be given upon arrival and can be used in the Glencoe Mountain Resort restaurant.
20. Please follow all safety instructions at the car park and on the course. For parking, please keep one bay clear of your vehicle on each side (so parking only in every second bay).
